



PUBLIC NOTICE

COMPLIANCE WITH CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY COUNCIL LEGISLATIONS (CIC ACT 14 OF 2013) -MANUFACTURING, SUPPLY OR SALE OF SUB-STANDARD CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

The Council, as established in terms of section 3 of the CIC Act, is mandated to promote, develop and regulate the construction industry in Eswatini. In exercising the above the Council is guided by the CIC Act, Levy Regulations, construction industry practices and standards.

Sections 42 and 43 of the CIC Act prohibit the use, manufacture, supply, and sale of substandard construction materials and other materials used in the construction industry or related activities. The CIC Act further prohibits the supply, use, and manufacture of substandard quality materials and provides that materials used in the construction industry should conform to the standards set by the Eswatini Standards Authority(SWASA).

This public notice underscores the utmost importance of Industry Stakeholders, Construction industry Manufacturers, and suppliers of construction materials to fully adhere to the CIC Act and the rigorous construction industry materials and suppliers' standards as provided by the Eswatini Standards Authority (SWASA).

Furthermore, Construction materials manufacturers and suppliers are hereby notified that the CIC 2024/2025 registration process commenced on Tuesday, the 19th of March 2024 and will conclude on Friday, the 31st of May 2024. We strongly urge all manufacturers and suppliers to ensure their compliance with the CIC Act during this registration period.
